  - That equals \_\_\_\_\_ feet across and \_\_\_\_\_ feet down.

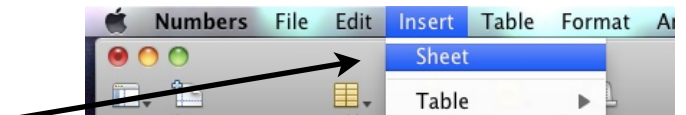
## Instructions

1. You have been given \$5,000 to furnish your bedroom.
