# Valley High School ICAP Requirements

# 1. WORKFORCE & POSTSECONDARY GOAL

- ▶ What do you want to do after high school? Students must describe their career goals and the postsecondary education they want to pursue to help achieve those career goals.
- The goal must be updated annually on the ICAP page of each student's College in Colorado (CIC) account.

## 2. PLAN OF STUDY

- What classes will you take throughout high school? Students build their 4-year plan of study from recommended courses based on career interests, higher education requirements, and/ or VHS graduation requirements
- ▶ The plan of study must be updated annually on the ICAP page of each student's College in Colorado (CIC) account.

# 3. COVER LETTER/PERSONAL STATEMENT

- How will you introduce yourself to potential employers, colleges and scholarship committees? Students must write either a cover letter or a personal statement.
- ▶ The cover letter/personal statement must be uploaded to the ICAP page of each student's CIC account.

## 4. RESUME

- What experiences have you had? Do you work, volunteer, or play sports? Students must create a resume to be used for job/college/scholarship applications.
- ▶ The resume must be completed in CIC or uploaded to the ICAP page of each student's CIC account.

#### 5. LETTER OF REFERENCE

- ▶ What will others ay about you? Students must get one letter of reference.
- ▶ The letter of reference must be uploaded to the ICAP page of each student's CIC account.

# 6. MOCK INTERVIEW

- ▶ Get some practice with job, college and scholarship interviews. Students must participate in one mock interview.
- Student must complete a verification form and upload it to their College in Colorado ICAP page.

## 7. JOB SHADOW

- What does someone in your ideal job actually do all day? Students must participate in one job shadow.
- Student must complete a verification form and upload it to their College in Colorado ICAP page.

# 8. COMMUNITY SERVICE

- ▶ Students must complete 5 hours of community service.
- Student must complete a verification form and upload it to their College in Colorado ICAP page.

## 9. COLLEGE/JOB APPLICATION

- Students must complete either a college or job application.
- ▶ The application must be completed in CIC or uploaded to the ICAP page of each student's CIC account.

# 10. SCHOLARSHIP/FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION

- Need money for college? Students must complete a scholarship or FAFSA application.
- The application must be completed in CIC or uploaded to the ICAP page of each student's CIC account.
